

SENATE No. 133.

[To accompany the petition of the mayor of the city of Worcester that said city may be authorized to appropriate money for the care and improvement of Boynton Park. Cities.]

Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Three.

AN ACT

To authorize the City of Worcester to appropriate Money for the Care and Improvement of Boynton Park.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The city of Worcester is author-
2 ized to spend such moneys as may, from time to
3 time, be appropriated therefor by the city council
4 of the city of Worcester, for the execution of the
5 trusts created by the deed of Charles Boynton,
6 dated September fourteenth, eighteen hundred
7 and ninety-eight, and recorded with Worcester

8 district registry of deeds, book fifteen hundred
9 and ninety-four, page thirty, upon the real estate
10 described in said deed, and the board of park
11 commissioners of the city of Worcester, or such
12 other board or officers, as the city council may by
13 ordinance designate, shall possess the same power
14 and authority and be charged with the same duties
15 and responsibilities touching said real estate, and
16 said city may otherwise, in the execution of said
17 trusts, act as to said real estate, as if it lay wholly
18 within the city of Worcester.

1 SECTION 2. No expenditures shall be incurred
2 under the authority of this act until an appropria-
3 tion sufficient for the estimated expense thereof
4 shall have been made by a vote of two-thirds of
5 each branch of the city council. Such expendi-
6 tures shall not exceed the appropriations therefor,
7 and all contracts involving expenditures in excess
8 of such appropriations shall be void.

1 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
