

SENATE No. 180.

[To accompany the petition of Henry S. Kittredge and others for legislation to prohibit the sale of explosive matches. Joint Judiciary.]

Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Three.

AN ACT

To prohibit the keeping, exposing for Sale or selling
of Explosive Matches in Cities and Towns.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the
same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. No person in any city or town of
2 this Commonwealth shall keep, expose for sale or
3 sell any match which will explode and ignite when
4 stepped upon.

1 SECTION 2. Any person violating the provi-
2 sions of this act shall be fined not less than ten
3 dollars for each offence.

1 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
