

[To accompany the petition of the selectmen and others of the town of Norwood for authority to appropriate money for public band concerts and music for public celebrations in said town. Towns.]

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Three.

AN ACT

To authorize the Town of Norwood to Appropriate Money for Public Band Concerts and Music for Public Celebrations.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The town of Norwood may at its
2 annual meeting, or at any special town meeting
3 called for the purpose, by vote appropriate each
4 year a sum not exceeding five hundred dollars to
5 be expended in paying for public band concerts,
6 or for music furnished for public celebrations.
7 The board of selectmen of said town shall have
8 full power and authority to provide for such con-
9 certs and music, and to expend the moneys when
10 so appropriated in the year for which said appro-
11 priation shall be made.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
