RESOLVE

Relative to Furnishing the New Armories at Cambridge,
New Bedford and Somerville.

1 *Resolved*, That there be allowed and paid out of the
2 treasury of the Commonwealth a sum not exceeding
3 seven thousand dollars, to be expended under the direc-
4 tion of the governor and council for the care and fur-
5 nishing, ready for occupancy, of the new armories now
6 being erected in the cities of Cambridge, New Bedford
7 and Somerville, as provided for in sections one hundred
8 and seven to one hundred and sixteen inclusive of
9 chapter sixteen of the Revised Laws.
