AN ACT

Relative to the Time of Payment of Municipal Debts  
incurred for Public Parks.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives  
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the  
same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Section eleven of chapter twenty-  
2 seven of the Revised Laws is hereby amended by  
3 inserting after the word "playgrounds," in the  
4 second line, the words: — and parks, — so as to  
5 read as follows: —

6 *Section 11.* Debts incurred for supplying the  
7 inhabitants with water, for acquiring land for  
8 public playgrounds and parks under the provisions  
9 of chapter twenty-eight, for a municipal lighting

10 plant under the provisions of chapter thirty-four,  
11 or in constructing sewers, shall be payable within  
12 thirty years; debts incurred in building school  
13 houses and other public buildings, and in pro-  
14 curing land therefor, within twenty years; and all  
15 other debts mentioned in section eight, within ten  
16 years, or by the city of Boston, within twenty  
17 years.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its  
2 passage.
