AN ACT

To provide for Seven Jury Sessions of the Superior Court in the County of Suffolk for the Trial of Civil Causes.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The superior court shall hold in
2 the county of Suffolk each month, except in the
3 months of July, August and September, seven
4 jury sessions for the trial of civil causes.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect on the
2 first day of September in the year nineteen hun-
3 dred and three.
