### AN ACT

Relative to the Production and Distribution of Antitoxin.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Section four of chapter seventy-  
2 five of the Revised Laws is hereby amended by  
3 inserting after the word "institutions," in the  
4 eleventh line thereof, the words:— and may pro-  
5 duce and distribute antitoxin to public charitable  
6 institutions and to the worthy poor.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its  
2 passage.
