AN ACT

To provide for the Production of Vaccine Lymph
by the State Board of Health at the Massachusetts
Agricultural College.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the
same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The state board of health is hereby
2 authorized and directed to cause vaccine lymph to
3 be produced under its direction at the Massa-
4 chusetts agricultural college, for free distribution
5 throughout the Commonwealth, and to employ
6 such agents and assistants as may be required for
7 this purpose.

1 SECTION 2. For the above purpose, the state
2 board of health is hereby authorized to erect at
3 the Massachusetts agricultural college a suitable
4 building, with the necessary equipment, and for
5 this purpose may expend from the treasury of the

6 Commonwealth a sum not exceeding
7 dollars. In order to carry on the production of
8 vaccine lymph as aforesaid, and to make such in-
9 vestigations as the state board of health may deem
10 necessary in regard to the best methods of pro-
11 ducing the same, the said board is hereby author-
12 ized to expend a yearly sum not exceeding
13 dollars.

1 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
