The committee on Towns, to whom was referred the communication from the Board of Harbor and Land Commissioners, proposing, under authority of section 7 of chapter 25 of the Revised Laws, changes in the boundary lines between the towns of Andover and Tewksbury, between the town of Medfield and the towns of Dover, Walpole and Norfolk, between the towns of Concord and Carlisle, between the town of Foxborough and the towns of Walpole and Norfolk and between the towns of Belmont and Watertown (House, No. 1309), reports, in part, the accompanying bill.

### AN ACT

To establish a Portion of the Boundary Line between the Towns of Concord and Carlisle.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The following described line shall  
2 hereafter be a part of the boundary line between  
3 the towns of Concord and Carlisle:—Beginning  
4 at a point in the present boundary line between  
5 the towns of Concord and Carlisle marked by a  
6 granite monument, lettered C C, standing on the  
7 easterly side of the Estabrook road in latitude  
8 forty-two degrees, thirty minutes, ten and seventy-  
9 one hundredths seconds, and longitude seventy-  
10 one degrees, twenty-one minutes, fourteen and  
11 sixty hundredths seconds; thence running south  
12 eighty-eight degrees, fifty-two minutes, thirty  
13 seconds east (true bearing), about nine thousand  
14 seven hundred feet to the center of Concord river.

15 All that portion of the present territory of the  
16 town of Carlisle lying south of the above de-  
17 scribed line shall be a part of the town of Concord,  
18 and all that portion of the present territory of the  
19 town of Concord lying north of the above  
20 described line shall be a part of the town of  
21 Carlisle.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its  
2 passage.
