AN ACT

Relative to the Tenure of Office of Certain Veterans of the Civil War.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the
same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Every veteran of the civil war in
2 the employment of a city, county or town who,
3 without his consent in writing, is removed from
4 such employment, or whose office is abolished,
5 shall be paid one-half the compensation he is
6 receiving when such employment ceases, until he
7 is re-employed by such city, county or town or
8 secures some other regular employment.

1 SECTION 2. The maximum amount of com-

2 pension under this act shall be six hundred
3 dollars a year.

1 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
