AN ACT

To provide for the Transportation to and from School of Children living upon Islands which are not provided with Schools.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The state board of education is
2 hereby authorized to furnish or provide trans-
3 portation to and from school for such children of
4 school age as may be living upon islands within
5 the Commonwealth which are not provided with
6 schools, in cases where the city or town within
7 the limits of which such islands are situated is
8 not required by law to provide such transporta-
9 tion.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
