[Bill accompanying the petition of Frederick S. Deitrick and others for legislation to provide evening sessions of police, district and municipal courts for the purposes of naturalization. Probate and Chancery. January 11.]

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Four.

AN ACT

To provide for Evening Sessions of the Police, Municipal and District Courts for the Purposes of Naturalization.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 A new section is hereby added to chapter one hun-
2 dred and sixty-six of the Revised Laws as follows:—

3 *Section 21.* Evening sessions of police, district and
4 municipal courts shall be held for the purposes of natu-
5 ralization within ten days after fifty applications have
6 been filed with the clerk of said court, and the judge and
7 officers of said court shall receive one day's pay in pro-
8 portion to their salaries for each evening sitting as herein
9 provided for.
