AN ACT

Making Appropriations for the Salaries and Expenses of the Commissioners of Savings Banks.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The sums hereinafter mentioned
2 are appropriated, to be paid out of the treasury of
3 the Commonwealth, from the ordinary revenue,
4 for the purposes specified, for the year ending on
5 the thirty-first day of December, nineteen hundred
6 and four, to wit:—

7 For the salary of the chairman of the commis-
8 sioners of savings banks, thirty-five hundred dol-
9 lars. [Rev. Laws, chap. 113.]

(Appropriation 1903, \$3,500.)

10 For the salaries of the two associate commis-
11 sioners of savings banks, three thousand dollars
12 each. [Rev. Laws, chap. 113.]

(Appropriation 1903, \$6,000.)

13 For the salary of the first clerk of the commis-

14 sioners, two thousand dollars. [Rev. Laws, chap.
15 113.]

(Appropriation 1903, \$2,000.)

16 For the salary of the second clerk of the com-
17 missioners, fifteen hundred dollars. [Rev. Laws,
18 chap. 113.]

(Appropriation 1903, \$1,500.)

19 For the salary of the third clerk of the commis-
20 sioners, twelve hundred dollars. [Acts 1902,
21 chap. 490.]

(Appropriation 1903, \$1,200.)

22 For such additional clerks and expert assistants
23 as the commissioners may deem necessary, a sum
24 not exceeding twenty-five hundred dollars. [Rev.
25 Laws, chap. 113.]

(Appropriation 1903, \$2,500.)

26 For travelling and incidental expenses of the
27 commissioners, a sum not exceeding three thou-
28 sand dollars. [Rev. Laws, chap. 113.]

(Appropriation 1903, \$3,000.)

29 For printing and binding the annual report of
30 the commissioners in two parts, a sum not exceed-
31 ing five thousand dollars. [Rev. Laws, chap. 9,
32 sect. 7; Acts 1902, chap. 438.]

(Appropriation 1903, \$5,000.)

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon
2 its passage.
