AN ACT

Making Appropriations for the Salaries and Expenses of the Massachusetts Highway Commissioners.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the
same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The sums hereinafter mentioned
2 are appropriated, to be paid out of the treasury of
3 the Commonwealth, from the ordinary revenue,
4 for the purposes specified, for the year ending on
5 the thirty-first day of December, nineteen hundred
6 and four, to wit:—

7 For the salaries of the Massachusetts highway
8 commissioners, the sum of eighty-five hundred
9 dollars. [Rev. Laws, chap. 47, sect. 1.]

(Appropriation 1903, \$8,500.)

10 For the salaries of the engineers, clerks and
11 assistants in the office of the Massachusetts high-
12 way commission, a sum not exceeding thirteen
13 thousand dollars. [Rev. Laws, chap. 47.]

(Appropriation 1903, \$13,000.)

14 For traveling and other expenses of the com-
15 missioners, printing, postage and necessary office
16 expenses, a sum not exceeding five thousand
17 dollars. [Rev. Laws, chap. 47.]

(Appropriation 1903, \$5,000.)

18 For rent of offices for use of the Massachusetts
19 highway commission, a sum not exceeding four
20 thousand seven hundred and fifty dollars. [Rev.
21 Laws, chap. 47.]

(Appropriation 1903, \$4,750.)

22 For care and repair of road-building machinery,
23 a sum not exceeding fifteen hundred dollars.
24 [Rev. Law, chap. 47, sect. 19.]

(Appropriation, 1903, \$1,500.)

25 For expenses in connection with the registra-
26 tion of motor vehicles and licensing of operators
27 thereof, a sum not exceeding five thousand dollars.
28 [Acts 1903, chap. 473.]

(Appropriation 1903, \$10,000.)

29 For printing and binding the annual report of
30 the Massachusetts highway commissioners, a sum
31 not exceeding twelve hundred dollars. [Rev.
32 Laws, chap. 9; Acts 1902, chap. 438.]

(Appropriation 1903, \$1,200.)

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
