AN ACT

Making Appropriations for Salaries and Expenses in
the Bureau of Statistics of Labor.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the
same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The sums hereinafter mentioned
2 are appropriated, to be paid out of the treasury
3 of the Commonwealth, from the ordinary revenue,
4 for the purposes specified, for the year ending on
5 the thirty-first day of December, nineteen hundred
6 and four, to wit:—

7 For the salary of the chief of the bureau of
8 statistics of labor, three thousand dollars. [Rev.
9 Laws, chap. 107.]

(Appropriation 1903, \$3,000.)

10 For the salary of the first clerk of the bureau of
11 statistics of labor, two thousand dollars. [Rev.
12 Laws, chap. 107.]

(Appropriation 1903, \$2,000.)

13 For the salary of the second clerk of the bureau
14 of statistics of labor, sixteen hundred and fifty
15 dollars. [Rev. Laws, chap. 107.]

(Appropriation 1903, \$1,650.)

16 For the salaries of the two special agents of the
17 bureau of statistics of labor, the sum of twenty-
18 four hundred dollars. [Rev. Laws, chap. 107.]

(Appropriation 1903, \$2,400.)

19 For such additional clerical assistance and for
20 such expenses of the bureau of statistics of labor
21 as may be necessary, a sum not exceeding thirteen
22 thousand eight hundred dollars. [Rev. Laws,
23 chap. 107.]

(Appropriation 1903, \$13,800.)

24 For expenses in connection with the annual
25 collection of statistics of manufacturers, a sum
26 not exceeding sixty-five hundred dollars. [Rev.
27 Laws, chap. 107.]

(Appropriation 1903, \$6,500.)

28 For expenses in connection with taking a special
29 census in towns having an increased resident
30 population during the summer months, a sum not
31 exceeding six hundred dollars. [Rev. Laws,
32 chap. 100, sect. 13.]

(Appropriation 1903, \$450.)

33 For printing and binding the annual reports
34 of the bureau of statistics of labor, a sum not ex-
35 ceeding four thousand dollars. [Rev. Laws, chap.
36 9 ; Acts 1902, chap. 438.]

(Paid in 1903, \$4,200.)

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
