RESOLVE

To authorize the Treasurer and Receiver General to borrow
Money in Anticipation of Revenue.

1 *Resolved*, That the treasurer and receiver general is
2 hereby authorized to borrow, in anticipation of the re-
3 ceipts of the present year, such sums of money as may
4 from time to time be necessary for the payment of
5 ordinary demands on the treasury, at any time before
6 the expiration of fifteen days after the meeting of the
7 next general court, at such rates of interest as shall be
8 found necessary; and that he shall repay any sums
9 borrowed under this resolve as soon as money sufficient
10 for the purpose, and not otherwise appropriated, is re-
11 ceived into the treasury.
