## Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Four.

### AN ACT

#### Making Appropriations for Salaries and Expenses in the Office of the State Board of Health.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives  
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the  
same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The sums hereinafter mentioned  
2 are appropriated, to be paid out of the treasury  
3 of the Commonwealth, from the ordinary revenue,  
4 for the purposes specified, for the year ending on  
5 the thirty-first day of December, nineteen hun-  
6 dred and four, to wit:—

7 For the salary of the secretary of the state  
8 board of health, three thousand dollars. [Rev.  
9 Laws, chap. 75, sect. 3.]

(Appropriation 1903, \$3,000.)

10 For the general work of the state board of  
11 health, including all necessary travelling expenses,  
12 a sum not exceeding twenty thousand dollars.  
13 [Rev. Laws, chap. 75.]

(Appropriation 1903, \$20,000.)

14 For salaries and expenses in connection with  
15 the inspection of milk, food and drugs, a sum not  
16 exceeding twelve thousand five hundred dollars.  
17 [Rev. Laws, chap. 75, sect. 6; Acts 1903, chap.  
18 467.]

(Appropriation 1903, \$12,500.)

19 For expenses in connection with the examina-  
20 tion of sewer outlets, a sum not exceeding seven  
21 thousand five hundred dollars. [Rev. Laws, chap.  
22 75, sect. 4; Acts 1902, chap. 541.]

(Appropriation 1903, \$7,500.)

23 For expenses in connection with the production  
24 and distribution of antitoxin and vaccine lymph,  
25 a sum not exceeding eight thousand dollars.  
26 [Acts 1903, chap. 480.]

(Appropriation 1903, \$5,000.)

27 For printing and binding the annual report, a  
28 sum not exceeding four thousand dollars. [Rev.  
29 Laws, chap. 9; Acts 1902, chap. 438.]

(Appropriation 1903, \$4,000.)

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its  
2<sup>d</sup> passage.
