## Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Four.

### AN ACT

Making Appropriations for continuing the Publication of the Province Laws.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The sums hereinafter mentioned  
2 are appropriated, to be paid out of the treasury of  
3 the Commonwealth, from the ordinary revenue,  
4 for the purpose of completing the preparation and  
5 publication of the acts and resolves of the province  
6 of Massachusetts Bay, during the year ending on  
7 the thirty-first day of December, nineteen hundred  
8 and four, to wit:—

9 For the salary of the secretary and executive  
10 officer, the sum of two thousand dollars. [Acts  
11 1894, chap. 387; 1899, chap. 477.]

(Appropriation 1903, \$2,000.)

12 For the salary of the chief clerk, fifteen hundred  
13 dollars. [Acts 1894, chap. 387; 1899, chap. 477.]

(Appropriation 1903, \$1,500.)

14 For clerical service and messenger, a sum not  
15 exceeding three thousand four hundred dollars.  
16 [Acts 1894, chap. 387; 1899, chap. 477.]

(Appropriation 1903, \$3,500.)

17 For stationery, postage, travelling and other  
18 necessary expenses in connection with the prepara-  
19 tion and publication of the provincial laws, a sum  
20 not exceeding two hundred dollars. [Acts 1894,  
21 chap. 387; 1899, chap. 477.]

(Appropriation 1903, \$150.)

22 For printing and binding such volumes as may  
23 be completed, a sum not exceeding six thousand  
24 dollars. [Acts 1894, chap. 387; 1899; chap. 477.]

(Appropriation 1903, \$3,000.)

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its  
2 passage.
