### AN ACT

To preclude from Certain Occupations Persons who do not declare an Intention of becoming Citizens of the United States.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. No person shall be employed in any  
2 department of the Commonwealth, or by any county,  
3 city or town, or by any person, association or corpora-  
4 tion contracting with them, or by any quasi-public  
5 corporation where the duties of the person so employed  
6 are to be entirely performed within the territorial limits  
7 of the Commonwealth, unless such person shall be a  
8 citizen of the United States or have made a primary

9 declaration of his intention to become a citizen of the  
10 United States.

1 SECTION 2. Any person, association or corporation  
2 knowingly and wilfully violating this act shall be pun-  
3 ished by a fine of not more than one hundred dollars  
4 for each offence.

1 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
