

Resolve accompanying the petition of Otto Muller for legislation to provide for the appointment of a commission to consider the matter of a trunk line sewer in the Merrimac valley. Drainage. January 28.

RESOLVE

To provide for the Appointment of a Commission to consider the Matter of a Trunk Line Sewer in the Merrimac Valley.

1 *Resolved*, That the governor, with the advice and con-
2 sent of the council, be requested to appoint, within thirty
3 days after the passage of this resolve, a commission of
4 five persons, citizens of the Commonwealth, one of whom
5 he shall designate as chairman, to investigate the matter,
6 and to determine the feasibility and cost of constructing
7 a trunk line sewer in the Merrimac valley from a point
8 in the state of New Hampshire to be designated by the
9 said commission, to tide water, and to report to the next
10 general court on or before the fifteenth day of January
11 in the year nineteen hundred and five, with such recom-
12 mendations for legislation as the commission may deem
13 expedient. The said commission may employ experts,
14 and may incur such reasonable expenses for clerical and
15 other assistance and such travelling expenses as may be
16 authorized by the governor and council. The commis-
17 sion shall receive no compensation for their services.
18 The total expense to be incurred under the provisions of
19 this resolve shall not exceed the sum of dollars.
