## Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

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In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Four.

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### RESOLVE

To provide for the Payment of a Sum of Money from the Treasury of the Commonwealth to the Medford Manufacturing Company.

1 *Resolved*, That there be allowed and paid out of the  
2 treasury of the Commonwealth to the treasurer of the  
3 Medford Manufacturing Company the sum of forty-nine  
4 dollars and fifty-three cents, that amount having by mis-  
5 take of the company been paid into the treasury of the  
6 Commonwealth as taxes for the year nineteen hundred  
7 and one, the said company having then ceased to do  
8 business and not being liable for a tax.
