Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Four.

AN ACT

Providing for the support of Textile Schools.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. There shall be appropriated, each year,
2 a sum not exceeding dollars for the use and
3 support of the textile schools in Lowell, New Bedford
4 and Fall River: *provided, however,* that the president
5 and secretary of the state board of education shall be,
6 ex-officiis, trustees of said schools, besides the two mem-
7 bers appointed by the governor and council under the
8 provisions of section twenty-two of chapter one hundred
9 and twenty-five of the Revised Laws.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
