Bill accompanying the petition of J. H. Benton, Jr., for legislation relative to Northern avenue and Sleeper street in the city of Boston. Harbors and Public Lands. January 29.

Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Four.

AN ACT

Relative to the Laying Out and Construction of Northern Avenue and Sleeper Street in the City of Boston.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The release by the New England Railroad
2 Company and its lessee to the city of Boston of land in-
3 cluded within Northern avenue as laid out by chapter
4 three hundred eighty-one of the acts of the year nineteen
5 hundred and three, provided to be made by said company
6 under section three of said act, shall be without prejudice
7 to the claim of said company against the Commonwealth,
8 to be paid for a part of said land under an agreement by
9 the Commonwealth with the New York and New England
10 Railroad Company and the Boston and Albany Railroad

11 Company, made on the first day of August, eighteen
12 hundred and eighty-two; and the board of harbor and
13 land commissioners, with the approval of the governor
14 and council, may make an equitable adjustment of said
15 claim, and the amount thereof as thus adjusted shall be
16 paid out of the "Flats and Improvement Fund" of the
17 Commonwealth upon the order of said board.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
