Bill accompanying the petition of Thomas H. Hickey for legislation relative to the sale of firearms or other weapons to minors. Mercantile Affairs. January 29.

AN ACT

Relative to the Sale of Weapons.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section ninety-two of chapter one hundred and two of
2 the Revised Laws is hereby amended by striking out the
3 word "fifteen," in the second line, and inserting in
4 place thereof the word:— sixteen,—and by inserting
5 after the word "firearms," in the same line, the words:
6 — air guns, — so as to read as follows:—

7 *Section 92.* Whoever sells or furnishes to a minor
8 under the age of sixteen years any firearms, air guns or
9 other dangerous weapon shall be punished by a fine of
10 not less than ten nor more than fifty dollars for each
11 offence; but instructors and teachers may furnish mili-
12 tary weapons to pupils for instruction and drill.
