

HOUSE No. 665.

Bill accompanying the petition of Charles M. Bryant, mayor of the city of Quincy, for legislation to authorize and direct the Metropolitan Park Commission to take and maintain Randolph avenue in the Blue Hills reservation. Metropolitan Affairs. February 1.

AN ACT

To authorize and direct the Metropolitan Park Commission to take and maintain Randolph Avenue, so called, in the Blue Hills Reservation.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The metropolitan park commission, created
2 by chapter four hundred and seven of the acts of the
3 year eighteen hundred and ninety-three, is hereby
4 authorized and directed to take and maintain as a part of
5 the Blue Hills reservation that portion of Randolph
6 avenue, in the city of Quincy and town of Milton, begin-
7 ning at Monatiquot stream on the line between Randolph
8 and Quincy and extending northerly through Quincy and
9 a part of Milton for a distance of about seventy-four
10 hundred feet.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
