AN ACT

To authorize the Board of Railroad Commissioners to grant Locations to Street Railway Companies in Certain Instances.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The board of railroad commissioners may, in the man-
2 ner and subject to the provisions contained in section
3 thirty of chapter one hundred and twelve of the Revised
4 Laws, relative to such grants by boards of aldermen and
5 selectmen, grant to a street railway company a location
6 for an extension of its tracks in any city or town when,
7 in the opinion of the board, such extension is necessary
8 to properly accommodate public travel between two or
9 more cities and towns.
