AN ACT

Relative to the Choice of Caucus Officers for Certain
Caucuses.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the
same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. In caucuses held only to elect delegates
2 to conventions held for the election of delegates to
3 national conventions, the caucus officials may be chosen
4 by the caucus itself, or may be named by the city or
5 town committee of the political party calling such
6 caucuses, if it so decides.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
