AN ACT

To provide for the Permanent Investment of the
Technical Education Fund, Commonwealth Grant.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the
same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The treasurer and receiver-general
2 is hereby authorized to pay into the Technical
3 Education Fund, Commonwealth grant, the sum
4 of four hundred twenty dollars and sixty-five
5 cents, being the sum required to make the fund
6 one hundred forty-two thousand dollars.

1 SECTION 2. The treasurer and receiver-general
2 is hereby authorized to invest said fund of one
3 hundred forty-two thousand dollars in the pur-
4 chase of a long term bond of the Commonwealth,
5 bearing interest at the rate of three and one-half
6 per centum per annum, payable semi-annually,
7 and, for the purpose of paying the premium on

8 such bond the treasurer and receiver-general is
9 hereby authorized, with the approval of the
10 governor, to pay from the treasury of the Com-
11 monwealth a sum not exceeding four thousand
12 dollars.

1 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
