## Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Four.

### AN ACT

To enlarge the Authority of Certain Precincts in the Town of Templeton to establish a Public Lighting Plant.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 The voting precincts numbered three and four in the  
2 town of Templeton, as a district, shall have the same  
3 authority to establish and maintain a plant for the manu-  
4 facture or purchase and distribution of gas for lighting  
5 and heating purposes as they now have under chapter  
6 two hundred and seventy-two of the acts of the year  
7 eighteen hundred and ninety-eight for establishing and  
8 maintaining a plant for the manufacture or purchase and  
9 distribution of electricity; and the terms, provisions  
10 and reservations of said chapter are made applicable to  
11 the additional authority given by this act.
