### RESOLVE

To provide for the Payment of a Sum of Money from the Metropolitan Sewerage Loan to Hannah M. McCarthy.

1 *Resolved*, That there be allowed and paid out of the  
2 metropolitan sewerage loan authorized by section four-  
3 teen of chapter four hundred and twenty-four of the acts  
4 of the year eighteen hundred and eighty-nine the sum of  
5 seven hundred and fifty dollars to Hannah M. McCarthy,  
6 widow of Patrick D. McCarthy, who was killed on the  
7 twenty-sixth day of May in the year nineteen hundred  
8 and two by an accident in a metropolitan sewer in Rox-  
9 bury, while in the discharge of his duties as an employee  
10 of the metropolitan water and sewerage board.
