AN ACT

Relative to Regulations concerning the Height and
Weight of Members of Fire Departments.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the
same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. No regulations concerning the
2 height and weight of persons who shall be eligible
3 to become members of the fire department in any
4 city or town which has accepted the provisions of
5 chapter nineteen of the Revised Laws relating to
6 the civil service shall be made or enforced except
7 by the city council of such city, by the selectmen
8 of such town or by such other board or officer
9 having authority to make appointments in the
10 fire department of such city or town.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon
2 its passage.
