HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES, March 11, 1904.

Jackson and others for legislation to provide for the consolidation of the Trinitarian Congregational Church and the Central Square Society in the town of Bridgewater, report the accompanying bill.

AN ACT

To authorize the Central Square Society in Bridgewater to consolidate with the Trinitarian Congregational Church in Bridgewater.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The name of the Trinitarian
2 Congregational Church in Bridgewater, incor-
3 porated by a special act of the General Court
4 approved on the third day of March in the year
5 eighteen hundred and twenty-six, is hereby
6 changed to the Central Square Congregational
7 Church in Bridgewater. The said church is
8 hereby authorized to hold real and personal prop-
9 erty to the amount of one hundred thousand
10 dollars.

1 SECTION 2. The Central Square Society, a
2 religious society in Bridgewater, incorporated

3 under the general law, is hereby authorized to
4 convey all its real and personal property to the
5 Central Square Congregational Church in Bridge-
6 water. If the said church shall accept the prop-
7 erty of the said society, all the existing financial
8 obligations of the said society shall become the
9 obligations of the said church. The said society
10 shall then be dissolved, if it shall pass a vote to
11 that effect.

1 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
