### AN ACT

Relative to the Place of Residence of County Employees.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. No person shall be employed in  
2 any capacity by any county unless such person is,  
3 at the time of his or her appointment, and con-  
4 tinues to be so long as his or her employment  
5 continues, a resident of such county.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall not be construed to  
2 prevent the temporary employment of experts or  
3 specialists for a special purpose, and it shall not  
4 apply to persons appointed by the governor, nor  
5 shall it apply to any person now employed by any  
6 county.

1 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon its  
2 passage.
