## Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Four.

### AN ACT

To establish the Boundary Line between the Towns of Middleton and Boxford.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The following described line shall  
2 hereafter be the boundary line between the towns  
3 of Middleton and Boxford:—Beginning at the  
4 present corner of the towns of Boxford, Middle-  
5 ton and North Andover at a granite monument  
6 lettered A—B—M, in latitude forty-two degrees,  
7 thirty-eight minutes, thirty and twelve-hundredths  
8 seconds and longitude seventy-one degrees, one  
9 minute, twenty-two and twelve hundredths sec-  
10 onds; thence south fifty-three degrees, fifty-three  
11 minutes east, true bearing, twelve thousand two  
12 hundred and forty-five feet to a granite monu-  
13 ment lettered B—M, standing five feet north of  
14 the bank of Ipswich river, in latitude forty-two

15 degrees, thirty-seven minutes, eighteen and  
16 eighty-one hundredths seconds, and longitude  
17 seventy degrees, fifty-nine minutes, nine and  
18 eighty-two hundredths seconds; thence in the  
19 same direction about forty feet to the centre of the  
20 river; thence in a generally easterly direction along  
21 the centre line of the river about three-quarters of a  
22 mile to the present corner of the towns of Box-  
23 ford, Middleton and Topsfield at a point about  
24 thirty-five feet north forty-one degrees, forty-one  
25 minutes west, true bearing, from a granite monu-  
26 ment lettered B—T—M, standing ten feet south  
27 of the river bank in the line between Middleton  
28 and Topsfield and in latitude forty-two degrees,  
29 thirty-seven minutes, sixteen and twenty hun-  
30 dredths seconds and longitude seventy degrees,  
31 fifty-eight minutes, thirty-five and sixty-five  
32 hundredths seconds.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its  
2 passage.
