## Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Four

### AN ACT

To establish the Salary of the Associate Judge of  
the Court of Land Registration.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives  
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the  
same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The salary of the associate judge  
2 of the court of land registration shall be forty-  
3 five hundred dollars a year.

1 SECTION 2. So much of section twelve of  
2 chapter one hundred and twenty-eight of the  
3 Revised Laws as is inconsistent herewith is hereby  
4 repealed.

1 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon its  
2 passage.
