## Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Four.

### AN ACT

To provide for submitting to the Voters of Certain Cities the Question of repealing the Provisions of the Law providing for Joint Caucuses of all Political Parties.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. In all cities subject to the pro-  
2 visions of chapter four hundred and fifty-four of  
3 the acts of the year nineteen hundred and three,  
4 providing for joint caucuses or primaries of all  
5 political and municipal parties, the question of its  
6 repeal shall be submitted to the voters at the next  
7 annual city election, and if a majority of the voters

8 voting thereon shall vote in favor of such repeal,  
9 the provisions of said chapter shall hereafter cease  
10 to apply to said city.

1 SECTION 2. In any city which has not adopted  
2 said provisions, the question of the adoption of  
3 the act may be placed upon the official ballot  
4 after two years upon petition of not less than ten  
5 per centum of the legal voters of said city.

1 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon its  
2 passage.
