AN ACT

Making Appropriations for Salaries and Expenses
in the Department of the Auditor of the Common-
wealth.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the
same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The sums hereinafter mentioned
2 are appropriated, to be paid out of the treasury of
3 the Commonwealth, from the ordinary revenue,
4 for the purposes specified, for the year ending on
5 the thirty-first day of December, nineteen hun-
6 dred and five, to wit: —

7 For the salary of the auditor, thirty-five hun-
8 dred dollars. [Rev. Laws, chap. 6, sect. 14.]

(Appropriation 1904, \$3,500.)

9 For the salary of the first clerk in the auditor's
10 department, twenty-five hundred dollars. [Rev.
11 Laws, chap. 6, sect. 14.]

(Appropriation 1904, \$2,500.)

12 For the salary of the second clerk in the audi-
13 tor's department, twenty-two hundred dollars.

14 [Rev. Laws, chap. 6, sect. 14.]

(Appropriation 1904, \$2,200.)

15 For the salaries of the extra clerks in the audi-
16 tor's department, forty-five hundred dollars.

17 [Rev. Laws, chap. 6, sect. 14.]

(Appropriation 1904, \$4,500.)

18 For stenographers and such additional clerical
19 assistance as the auditor may find necessary for
20 the proper dispatch of public business, a sum not
21 exceeding forty-five hundred dollars. [Rev.
22 Laws, chap. 6, sect. 14; Acts 1902, chap. 177;
23 1903, chap. 120.]

(Appropriation 1904, \$4,500.)

24 For the salary of the messenger in the audi-
25 tor's department, nine hundred dollars. [Rev.
26 Laws, chap. 6, sect. 14.]

(Appropriation 1904, \$900.)

27 For the compensation of a state printing ex-
28 pert, a sum not exceeding fifteen hundred dol-
29 lars. [Rev. Laws, chap. 6, sect. 18.]

(Appropriation 1904, \$1,500.)

30 For incidental and contingent expenses in the
31 department of the auditor, a sum not exceeding
32 fifteen hundred dollars. [Rev. Laws, chap. 6,
33 sect. 25.]

(Appropriation 1904, \$1,500.)

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
