AN ACT

Making Appropriations for the Board of Registration in Dentistry.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The sums hereinafter mentioned
2 are appropriated, to be paid out of the treasury
3 of the Commonwealth, from the ordinary revenue,
4 for the purposes specified, for the year ending on
5 the thirty-first day of December, nineteen hundred
6 and five, to wit:—

7 For the salaries of the members of the board of
8 registration in dentistry, seventeen hundred dol-
9 lars. [Acts 1902, chap. 505; 1903, chap. 228.]

(Appropriation 1904, \$1,700.)

10 For clerical services, postage, printing, travel-
11 ling, and other necessary expenses of the board of
12 registration in dentistry, to include printing the
13 annual report, a sum not exceeding twenty-two

14 hundred and fifty dollars. [Acts 1902, chaps.
15 438 and 505.]

(Appropriation 1904, \$2,250.)

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
