AN ACT

Making an Appropriation for the Instruction of the Adult Blind at their Homes by the Perkins Institution and Massachusetts School for the Blind.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The sum of five thousand dollars
2 is hereby appropriated, to be paid out of the
3 treasury of the Commonwealth, from the ordinary
4 revenue, to provide for the instruction of the adult
5 blind at their homes by the Perkins institution
6 and Massachusetts school for the blind, for the
7 year ending on the thirty-first day of December,
8 nineteen hundred and five. [Acts 1902, chap.
9 297.]

(Appropriation 1904, \$5,000.)

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
