AN ACT

Making an Appropriation for the Board of Registration in Veterinary Medicine.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The sum of one thousand dollars
2 is hereby appropriated, to be paid out of the
3 treasury of the Commonwealth, from the ordinary
4 revenue, for the payment of salaries and expenses
5 of the board of registration in veterinary medicine
6 during the year ending December thirty-first,
7 nineteen hundred and five, as authorized by
8 chapter two hundred and forty-nine of the acts of
9 the year nineteen hundred and three.

(No appropriation 1904.)

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
