Bill accompanying the petition of Joseph E. Fiske and others for legislation to authorize the proprietors of the Woodlawn Cemetery to increase the number of shares and change the par value of its capital stock. Mercantile Affairs. January 13.

AN ACT

To authorize the Proprietors of the Woodlawn Cemetery to
Change the Par Value of its Capital Stock.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The proprietors of the Woodlawn ceme-
2 tery, a corporation established under the general laws of
3 Massachusetts, in the year eighteen hundred and eighty-
4 two, and located in the town of Wellesley, may at a
5 meeting called for the purposes, change the par value of
6 its capital stock from one hundred dollars a share to ten
7 dollars a share, may increase the number of shares from
8 fifty to five hundred, and thereafter may issue ten of the
9 new shares in place of each of the old shares.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
