### AN ACT

To provide for simplifying the Ballots at Caucuses for the Election of Delegates to Conventions to nominate Senators and Representatives.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. At caucuses or primaries held for  
2 the election of delegates to conventions to nominate  
3 candidates for the state senate or for the house  
4 of representatives, the name of the delegates may  
5 be omitted from the ballot: *provided*, that the  
6 names of the persons for whom they are selected  
7 to vote shall be contained therein, and the names  
8 of such persons shall be printed in alphabetical  
9 order.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its  
2 passage.
