Bill accompanying the petition of Heman S. Cook and other for legislation to provide for the reclamation of the province lands for the benefit of Provincetown harbor. Harbors and Public Lands. January 17.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Five.

AN ACT

Making an Appropriation for the Reclamation of the Province Lands for the Benefit of Provincetown Harbor.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The sum of ten thousand dollars
2 is hereby appropriated, to be paid out of the
3 treasury of the Commonwealth from the ordinary
4 revenue, to be expended during the period of
5 three years after the passage of this act, under
6 the direction of the board of harbor and land
7 commissioners, for the reclamation of the province
8 lands belonging to the Commonwealth in the

9 county of Barnstable, as a means toward the
10 preservation of Provincetown harbor.

1 SECTION 2. Of the said amount there shall be
2 expended not more than one third in any one
3 year, except that if less than two thirds of the
4 whole sum hereby appropriated shall have been
5 spent during the first two years the remainder
6 of said two thirds may be added to the one third
7 set apart for the third year.

1 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
