Bill accompanying the petition of John B. Moran for legislation to authorize appeals by consumers under the act to provide for the consolidation of certain gas companies in the city of Boston and vicinity. Public Lighting. January 20.

AN ACT

To authorize Certain Appeals by Consumers of the Product of Certain Gas Companies in the City of Boston and Vicinity.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section four of chapter four hundred and
2 seventeen of the acts of the year nineteen hundred and
3 three is hereby amended by inserting, after the words
4 "Gas Company," in the twenty-third line of said section,
5 the words:—*any consumer of gas sold by any one of the*
6 *corporations mentioned in section one.*

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
