Bill accompanying the petition of Sinclair Kennedy and others for legislation to extend the civil service to the counties. Public Service. January 20.

Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Five.

AN ACT

To extend the Application of the Civil Service Law
to Counties.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the
same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Section six of chapter nineteen of
2 the Revised Laws is hereby amended by adding
3 after the word "several," in the third line thereof,
4 the words:— *counties and*; and adding after the
5 word "several," in the fifth line, the words:—
6 *counties and*,—so that the section as amended
7 shall read as follows:—

8 *Section 6.* The commissioners shall from time
9 to time prepare rules regulating the selection of

10 persons to fill appointive positions in the govern-
11 ment of the Commonwealth and of the several
12 *counties and* cities thereof and the selection of
13 persons to be employed as laborers or otherwise
14 in the service of the Commonwealth and said
15 several *counties and* cities, and altering, rescind-
16 ing, amending or adding to the rules now estab-
17 lished. Such rules may be of general or limited
18 application and shall take effect only when ap-
19 proved by the governor and council.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
