

Bill accompanying the petition of George W. Patten for legislation to establish the salary of the assistant bookkeeper in the department of the Treasurer and Receiver General. Public Service. January 23.

Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Five.

AN ACT

To establish the Salary of the Assistant Bookkeeper in the Department of the Treasurer and Receiver General.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. From and after the first day of
2 January in the year nineteen hundred and five the
3 assistant bookkeeper in the department of the
4 treasurer and receiver general shall receive a
5 salary of fifteen hundred dollars a year.

1 SECTION 2. So much of section four of chapter
six of the Revised Laws as is inconsistent with
3 this act is hereby repealed.

1 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
