Bill accompanying the petition of Samuel B. Bird and others for legislation to authorize the town of Framingham to sell and convey certain real estate used for school purposes and to erect a new high school building. Towns. January 23.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Five.

AN ACT

To authorize the Conveyance of Certain Real Estate used for School Purposes by the Town of Framingham.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The inhabitants of the town of Framing-
2 ham are hereby authorized to sell and convey any or all
3 of the real estate conveyed to it under the provisions of
4 chapter one hundred and seventy-eight of the acts of the
5 year eighteen hundred and fifty-one free and discharged
6 from any trust whatsoever, and any deed or deeds con-
7 veying the same shall be executed by the treasurer of
8 said town for the time being in the name and behalf of
9 said inhabitants.

1 SECTION 2. So much of chapter one hundred and
2 seventy-eight of the acts of the year eighteen hundred
3 and fifty-one as is inconsistent with this act is hereby
4 repealed.

1 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect as soon as the
2 same shall have been accepted by the inhabitants of
3 the town of Framingham at a meeting called for that
4 purpose.
