

Bill accompanying the petition of Edward H. O'Brien for legislation to provide that the Worcester Insane Hospital shall conduct its sewage into the sewerage system of the city of Worcester. Public Charitable Institutions. January 24.

AN ACT

Relative to the Disposition of the Sewage of the Worcester Insane Hospital.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Sewage from the Worcester insane hos-
2 pital shall be discharged into the sewer system of the
3 city of Worcester, and no part of the said sewage shall
4 be discharged into any lake or river. The trustees of
5 the said hospital shall see to the construction of such
6 connecting pipes or other works as may be necessary to
7 carry out the provisions of this act, and may expend
8 for this purpose, from any appropriation made for the
9 hospital, such sums as may be necessary. The disposi-
10 tion of the sewage hereby directed shall be made not
11 later than the first day of _____, in the year nineteen
12 hundred and five.

1 SECTION 2. Except as above provided, this act shall
2 take effect upon its passage.
