

HOUSE No. 818.

Bill accompanying the petition of S. E. Buck for legislation to provide for the protection of persons making assignments of wages. Probate and Chancery. January 26.

Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Five.

AN ACT

To provide for the Protection of Persons making
Assignments of Wages.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. No assignment of wages shall be
2 valid unless recorded in the office of the clerk of
3 the city or town in which the assignor resides at
4 the time of such record.

1 SECTION 2. No assignment of wages shall be
2 valid against any person or corporation obliged by
3 law to make weekly payments to his employees
4 unless assented to by such person or corporation
5 in writing.

1 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
