AN ACT

Making an Appropriation for Certain Expenses at
the Taunton Insane Hospital.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the
same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. A sum not exceeding nine thou-
2 sand dollars is hereby appropriated, to be paid
3 out of the treasury of the Commonwealth, from
4 the ordinary revenue, for the purpose of meeting
5 certain expenses incurred by the trustees of the
6 Taunton insane hospital during the year nineteen
7 hundred and four in anticipation of the receipts
8 of said hospital. This amount is to be reimbursed
9 to the revenue from the Taunton insane hospital
10 fund as soon as sufficient money is in said fund.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
